What we offer

return counseling and individual support

- initial consultations, intensive individual support through advice and support, organizational help for a dignified and safe return

qualification and further training courses

- in the areas of: language training, business start-ups, crafts, logistics, IT and software, design & e-commerce, solar and wind power energy, gastronomy, cosmetics, hairdressing, nail design, tailoring and sewing
- homeland courses - school and native language courses for children between the ages of 6 and 18

assistance during the return process and reintegration in the home country

- organizational assistance and materials (working and learning materials, technical equipment, work clothes, hardware and software, tools, school materials for children, travel expenses and much more)
- support with applications and communication with authorities
- individual qualification and education offers in the home country (online)
